No later than, (September 9, 2022), <u>two (2) weeks</u> before the scheduled date for the General Meeting of the Association, the Head Office of the CCGA (C&A), shall send to each member electronically in the District eligible to vote a copy of all the names and qualifications thus received.

Nominations of Executive Officers:

Executive Officers, other than the President and the Past President, shall be elected by the Board at a <u>meeting held by the Board immediately after the Annual General Meeting</u> as per the order prescribed for the respective positions.
