### Replacing your Pleasure Craft Operator Card

A Pleasure Craft Operator Card is good for life.

If you need to replace a lost or damaged Pleasure Craft Operator Card, you will need to contact the course provider who issued it.

#### **Please note:**

1. Only currently [accredited course providers](https://tc.canada.ca/sites/default/files/migrated/course_providers_prestataires_de_cours.pdf) (link below) may issue replacement cards.

2. Course providers charge a fee for replacing Pleasure Craft Operator Cards.

An agent will look up your name in a national database of card holders and tell you what you need to do next.
